Palpung Yeshe Chökhör Ling Europe is a Tibetan Buddhist community with its seat in Austria. Currently it entertains branch centers in Austria, Germany and Poland.

PYCL is a member of the Austrian Buddhist Society and legally organised and structured as society. Spiritually, PYCL is an independent, direct branch of the Palpung Congregation of H. E. Chamgon Kuanding Tai Situ Rinpoche with its seat in H. P., northern India.

With the blessing and through authorization by H. E. Kuanding Tai Situ Rinpoche, Supreme Head of the Palpung Congregation, Palpung Yeshe Chökhör Ling Europe is under the direction of Gelongma Lama Palmo, a native Austrian.

The Supreme Head of all Tibetan Buddhists, H. H. The Dalai Lama, as well as the Supreme Head of the Kagyu tradition, H. H. The Gyalwang Karmapa support the project ideally and with their blessing.

Palpung Yeshe Chökhör Ling Europe with all its activities is dedicated to the development of peace which starts with and within one's self, radiating to all sentient beings. It is our active contribution to World Peace.

Currently the project operates from Vienna and from there procures all its own branches. Succeedingly, a project outside of Vienna is planned which will enable all aspects of spiritual life to be led on one spot in a community – a space for monastics, lay people, families, retreatants and visitors.

The main aspect of his undertaking will be a nunnery as a unique project in Europe and one of the very few ones worldwide. Further, a number of stupas, symbolizing the awakened heart of Buddha, an isolated area for retreats for individual meditation, two traditional Three-years-retreats, an additional own house for lay people who desire to live in a spiritual community, and an interreligious and intercultural center are planned on the future premises.
